**Fort Belvoir youth honored for photo image**

And sometimes the two concepts come together in a photograph.  
Using a technique called double exposure, the West Springfield High School senior produced a compelling black and white photograph that visually combined two America's history and its future.

In the photograph, a young girl holding a flower stands next to a soldier in a military uniform. The girl's face is superimposed over the soldier's face, symbolizing the connection between the past and the future.  
Bear's photograph won first place in the 2007 contest. She is a member of the Fort Belvoir Youth Center and a member of the National Honor Society.
