

Carolina Hurricanes Third Jersey Fact Sheet



What was the inspiration behind introducing a third jersey for the 2008-09 season?

Since third jerseys gained popularity throughout the NHL, the Hurricanes have had a lot of feedback from fans over the last four or five years pertaining to when the team would introduce an alternate jersey of its own. After 10 seasons in North Carolina, the time seemed right to do so this year.

What is the story behind the new identity? What has changed in the jersey?

The development of the third jersey began in October 2003. With the popularity of the secondary logo and the way in which the Triangle is represented in that symbol, it made sense for it to serve as the focal point. Since our primary team colors are red, black and white, and our other sweaters are red and white, it made sense to choose black as the main color of this new look.

Is the third jersey an Rbk EDGE jersey?

Yes, all third jerseys will have the same Rbk EDGE technology found in the home and away jerseys.

On which dates will the alternate uniforms be worn this season?

The team will wear the third jerseys for 15 home games this season, beginning with the team's game against the defending Stanley Cup champion Detroit Red Wings on Oct. 13 at the RBC Center. Here is a complete list of the home games in which the Hurricanes will wear their third jerseys:
